RESEARCH CENTERS AND INITIATIVES

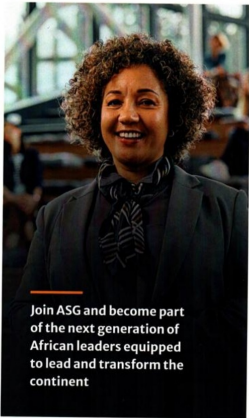
In addition to the educational programs, ASG will be home to four key research centres focused on advancing knowledge in areas critical to Africa's future:

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

Master of Public Administration (MPA)

Duration: 2 years (full-time)
Overview: ASG's flagship MPA program will equip students with advanced skills, models, mindsets, and networks in public policy, governance, and leadership, with a curriculum grounded in African realities and global standards. It is aimed at emerging leaders committed to driving impactful and meaningful change across the continent for the public good.

02

Executive Master of Public Administration (EMPA)

Duration: 2 years (part-time, hybrid)
Overview: Designed for mid-to-senior level professionals with real-world experience who are seeking to gain transformative leadership and governance skills, knowledge, and networks to help them become more effective leaders in understanding, solving, and taking on complex and bolder problems for the next phase in their careers. As the EMPA will blend remote learning with flexible in-person sessions at ASG, its flexible format allows executives to balance the program with their professional responsibilities.

General Executive Courses

Duration: ~2-3 weeks
Overview: These intensive, short-term courses are tailored for senior executives seeking to deepen their knowledge, skillsets, mindset, and networks for governance, policy, and leadership. Each course will focus on critical areas of public administration and equips leaders with actionable strategies to tackle complex challenges and enhance their impact.

Interviews may be conducted for some candidates to further evaluate their vision for impact.
